each night of Chanukah:

בְּרוּךְ אַתָּה יי, אֱלֹהֵינוּ מֶלֶךְ הָעוֹלָם, אֲשֶׁר קִדְּשָׁנוּ
בְּמִצְוֹתָיו, וְצִוָּנוּ לְהַדְלִיק נֵר שֶׁל חֲנֻכָּה.

Baruch atah Hashem, Elokeinu melech ha-olam, asher kid'shanu
b'mitzvotav, vitzivanu l'hadlik ner shel Chanukah.

*Blessed are You, Lord our G-d, King of the Universe, Who has sanctified us
with His Commandments and has commanded us to light the Chanukah
lamps.*

בְּרוּךְ אַתָּה יי, אֱלֹהֵינוּ מֶלֶךְ הָעוֹלָם, שֶׁעָשָׂה נִסִּים
לְאֲבוֹתֵינוּ בַּיָּמִים הָהֵם בְּזִמַּן הַזֶּה.

Baruch atah Hashem, Elokeinu melech ha-olam, she'asah nisim
la'avoteinu bayamim hahem bazeman hazeh.

*Blessed are You, Lord our G-d, King of the Universe, Who has done
miracles for our fathers in bygone days, at this time.*

We also recite the Shehecheyanu
on the first night of Chanukah:

בְּרוּךְ אַתָּה יי, אֱלֹהֵינוּ מֶלֶךְ הָעוֹלָם, שֶׁהֶחַיֵּנוּ, וְקִיְּמָנוּ,
וְהַגִּיעָנוּ לְזִמַּן הַזֶּה.

Baruch atah Hashem, Elokeinu melech ha-olam, shehecheyanu,
v'kiyemanu, v'higianu lazeman hazeh.

*Blessed are You, Lord our G-d, King of the Universe, Who
has given us life, sustained us and brought us to this time.*
